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My Organizations

Point K is structured for collaboration between organizations. To use the Organizational Assessment Tool, the Logic Model Builder, or the Evaluation Plan Builder, you must belong to at least one organization--which can be a legal corporate entity (e.g., "Innovation Network, Inc."), an informal working group (e.g., "Best Practices Discussion Group"), or your own personal project (e.g., "Simone's Pet Project").

- If you already belong to an organization, it is listed below.
- If you believe a colleague may have already registered your organization in Point K, click **Join an Organization**. This will let you search for an organization by name and request membership.
- If your organization does not turn up in the search, or if you are sure no-one else would have registered your organization, click **Add New Organization**.

NOTE: If you created an organization, you are automatically its **Administrator**. You may designate other members to be co-administrators. An organization **must** have at least one Administrator - you can't demote yourself or delete your own membership unless you have already designated another Administrator. Administrators are responsible for:

- Approving requests for membership in an organization,
- Managing the organization's membership, and
- Keeping the organization's basic information up to date in the system.

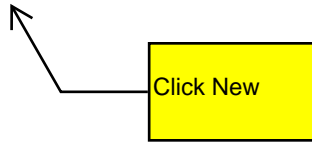
